Brief note on the COVID-19 related activities carried out at ICMR-NICED, Kolkata

- 1. NICED-VRDL is a regional centre for testing clinical samples for COVID-19 for the state of West Bengal. During earlier days of the pandemic, NICED-VRDL also provided diagnosis support to north-eastern states, Jharkhand, Odisha, Sikkim.
- 2. In addition of testing, NICED-VRDL provided training to the staff of all Govt. (both State and Central) and non Govt. organizations in the state. It also acts as quality control and quality assurance centre for other testing labs of the state of West Bengal.
- 3. NICED is one of the ICMR's validation lab for validating COVID-19 RT-PCR kits and RNA Isolation kits. As of May 15th 2020, 5 RT-PCR kits and 3 RNA Isolation kits have been validated and results have been forwarded to ICMR/NIV.
- 4. It is also one of the regional Depot of ICMR for storage and distribution of diagnostic kits and reagents to labs in eastern zones. The states under NICED Depot are West Bengal, Jharkhand, Tripura and Sikkim.
- 5. On the directives of EMR Division, Ministry of Health, Govt. of India, Dr. Alok Kr. Chakrabarti, Scientist E, NICED became member of Central RRT and supervised the Implementation of Cluster Containment Plan, Microplan and hospital preparedness for COVID-19 since 18th April, 2020 to 1st May, 2020 alongwith other team members.
- 6. Whole Genome Sequencing (WGS) of SARS CoV-2 virus from the clinical samples has been carried out in collaboration with NIBMG, Kalyani and IISC, Bangalore and jointly published research article:
